- G.S.R. 122.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and in partial supersession of the Directorate of Printing, Government of India Stationery Office and Department of Publications (Class I Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1963 in sofar as they relate to the post of Controller of Stationery, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Government of India Stationery Office in the Ministry method of recruitment to the post of Controller of Stationery, in the Government of India Stationery Office in the Ministry of Urban Development, namely:—
- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Government of India Stationery Office, (Controller of Stationery) Recruitment Rules, 2009.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of said post, its classification and the Pay Band and Grade Pay/Pay Scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.
 - 4. Disqualification.—No person,—
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commisssion relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen, Other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
